This facility was developed by Christenson Developments and designed by Roman Kujath Architects.

This facility is rated for the Alberta Building Code B2 occupancy and includes dementia care and designated assisted living. Special attention was given to the lighting in the entire facility to create a comfortable visual atmosphere for residents as well as providing the necessary higher levels of illumination needed for aging eyes.
